PRECAUTIONS: Keep out of the reach of children.

Store in original containers, tightly closed, in a cool dry, well ventilated place. Do not eat, drink or smoke while using. Avoid skin contact and inhalation of spray mist. Wear overalls, gloves and goggles while mixing and spraying. Remove protective clothing and wash hands and exposed skin before meals and after work. Wash protective clothing daily after work.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse container and empty rinsate into spray tank. Ensure container is completely empty. Recycle through the Agrecovery™ scheme or, if this is not possible, burn if permitted and circumstances, especially wind direction allow, otherwise bury in landfill.

SHELF LIFE: When stored appropriately this product should show no significant degradation for 2 years from date of manufacture. Contact your supplier for further information about the use of any product that is older than this.

FIRST AID: If Swallowed DO NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre **0800 POISON (0800 764 766)** or a doctor immediately.

If in Eyes Hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

If on Skin If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water for 15 minutes. Do not scrub the skin. Avoid spreading material on unaffected skin.

If Inhaled Remove patient to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-nose. Get medical attention if symptoms develop. Remove contaminated clothing and shoes immediately.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

DO NOT use during hot periods of the day. Apply morning or evening when temperatures are cooler.

Re-apply 5 – 7 days later or as necessary. Shake container before opening. Maintain good agitation while spraying.

CAUTION: Do not use **CLENZA** on Ornamentals and indoor crops unless testing has demonstrated crop safety..

COMPATIBILITY: CLENZA is compatible with copper hydroxide fungicides and sulphur for use in grapes. (see Adjuvant use above) Add **CLENZA** to the spray tank only after other products have been added and are thoroughly mixed. Before using large quantities, check compatibility of the mixture with a jar test and observe all label precautions. The addition of wetting or sticking agents other than DuWett is not recommended.

WATER HARDNESS :

CLENZA. Caution is required when mixing in hard water. Conduct testing before commercial use.

DO NOT USE if any compatibility issues are noted.

Precipitation of the product in the spray tank and mineral deposits on fruit can occur.

WITHHOLDING PERIOD: 28 days grapes
14 days other Outdoor crops

Crop	Target	Use Rate	Comments
Vineyard Grapes (Excluding Kiwifruit)	Botrytis	Apply 2 litres CLENZA / 100 litres water (min use rate 10 litres /ha) CLENZA can be applied at any growth stage throughout the season until 28 days before harvest. Late season applications are best applied before wet weather events. Keep application intervals close (7 – 14 days) over extended wet periods.	Water rate: 200 – 500 litres /ha . Higher water rates will give better coverage and botrytis control. If CLENZA is used at 10 litres /ha with low water rates (200 – 250 litres/ /ha) add the adjuvant DuWett super spreader.
Outdoor Crops 'Not for use on Kiwifruit'	For the control of soft bodied insects eg Aphids, Thrips, Mealybug, Two Spotted Mite, European Mite and Whitefly.	Apply 1.5 – 2.0 litres of CLENZA to 100 litres water	Use with a suitable water rate /ha that ensures complete coverage to the point of runoff. It is important that the spray makes direct contact with pests. Higher water rates will give better coverage and better insect control. Du-Wett super spreader may be added to the tank if lower water rates are used.
Adjuvant use	To improve coverage of fungicides and insecticides on outdoor crops.	Apply 500mls of CLENZA per 100 litres of spray mix.	CLENZA used as an adjuvant in the spray mix with sulphur will aid powdery mildew control in grapes. CLENZA used as an adjuvant in the spray mix with copper hydroxide products can aid downy mildew and powdery mildew control in grapes Do not use this tank mix when crops are flowering.
