PRODUCT DISPOSAL: Ensure unwanted product is used by another operator strictly in accordance with label directions. Do not allow product to enter waterways, drains or sewers.

HANDLING PRECAUTIONS: When mixing or applying wear protective clothing as prescribed for the mixing partners used. Wear gloves and goggles when handling SPEEDO®. Do not eat or drink while using. Wash hands and face before meals and after work. Wash protective clothing after work.

STORAGE: Keep out of reach of children. Store in closed, original container in a well ventilated area, out of direct sunlight. Under conditions below 0°C SPEEDO® may thicken and become cloudy. It returns to a normal clear liquid state above 0°C. Storage must be generally in accordance with NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals. See the HAZNOTE for further information.

FIRST AID: If swallowed do **NOT** induce vomiting. For advice, contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately. If skin, hair or eye contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin, hair and/or eyes with running water for several minutes.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

SPEEDO® is a penetrating spray adjuvant suitable for use with certain herbicides, insecticides, fungicides and desiccants, where an oil-based adjuvant is specified on the label.

The combined effects of the esterified vegetable oils in combination with the wetting and spreading characteristics of the non-ionic surfactants in SPEEDO® give excellent spreading and penetration through waxy plant cuticles. SPEEDO® will also reduce spray droplet evaporation rates.

Follow all directions for use on the SPEEDO® label and on the pesticide label. The pesticide manufacturer's recommendations and directions take precedence over directions contained on this label.

MIXING

Follow the mixing directions on pesticide label. Half fill spray tank with water and add the required amount of agrichemical first with agitation running.

Complete filling of the tank and then add the required amount of SPEEDO®. Continue agitation until spraying is complete.

CROP SAFETY

In some situations SPEEDO® may reduce crop selectivity. Care must be exercised when applying SPEEDO® on sensitive crops when grown under drought stress, high temperatures, and high humidity. If selectivity is in doubt, test on a small area before treating larger areas. Note crop safety statements on the agrichemical label

RECOMMENDATIONS:

SPEEDO® can be used wherever an oil-based adjuvant is recommended on the agrichemical label, unless use of an esterified seed oil is specifically excluded. Use 250mL/100Litres when applying sprays on sensitive crops in high water volumes. For lower water volume spraying, use 500 ml/100 litres of water.

Desiccants: Use 500 ml to 2 litres/100 litres. SPEEDO® may be used in the place of crop oils. Use of the higher rate may be required when plants are subject to severe stress.

Fungicides: Use 250ml to 500 ml/100 litres of water where penetration and spread enhancement is required, eg on vegetable crops such as onions.

Use the higher rate in low water volumes.

Herbicides: Use 250ml to 500ml/100 litres for selective herbicides. Use the higher rate in low water volumes. Use 500ml to 1 litre / 100 litres where a higher rate of oil or ESO is recommended on the product label. May be used with grass herbicides such as Aramo®1 and with herbicides such as Spinnaker®1, Topik®2 and Twinax®2.

Insecticides: SPEEDO® may be applied with a range of insecticides to improve spreading and cuticular uptake. Use 250 to 500 ml/100 litres. eg Ascend®1, apply as per label directions for recommended Esterified Seed Oil (ESO) products.
